Our safety training courses are designed with the objective of creating safer work environments. Classes include technical knowledge along with hands-on practical exercises where students practice what they have learned. This ensures they leave with the skills they will need to do their job safely.

Classes have a **12 to 1 student to instructor ratio**. This allows for increased practical hands-on training time which results in a better trained, safer worker on the job.

The **Ladder Safety Training (LSC)** course is designed and intended for any worker required to use a portable or fixed ladder while performing their assigned work or task. This is a 4 hour course that includes theory and practical training; the new CSA Z11 standard for portable ladders is referenced. Participants will select, inspect, set up, climb, and carry various step, platform and extension ladders. Upon successful completion of this course, participants will receive a certificate for the use of ladders.
