DOP/PAO Testing of HEPA Filtered Equipment

- We have a comprehensive DOP Technician Certification Program that ensures testing is completed professionally, safely and in accordance with applicable regulations
- Our programs and operations adhere to 6S principles and insurance is in place to cover all facets of the services Hazmasters provides

What is a DOP/PAO test? A process that challenges HEPA filtered equipment to ensure it is safe to use in hazardous environments. An aerosol generator is used to convert DOP or PAO oil to an aerosol with particle sizes down to .3 micron. A photometer then measures the amount of particulates in the exhaust air stream.

Respiratory Fit Testing

- Qualitative and quantitative fit tests for respiratory protection are available at our location or at your job site
- For optimal protection, a respirator must fit properly and form a good seal on your face when in use; this is verified through a proper fit test
- Upon successful test completion, fit test record cards are provided listing respirator model and worker identification
- All testing is done in compliance with CSA Standard Z94.4-11
