Children are more than twice as likely to be struck by a vehicle on Halloween vs any other day of the year. Be alert, and follow the safety tips below to make sure that everyone goes home safely at the end of the night!



SLOW DOWN!
Especially in residential areas - children may be unpredictable and stray from the sidewalk.

CLEAR WALKWAYS!
Make sure that the steps up to your house are well lit, and decorations are not in the way.

BE VISIBLE!
Use flashlights, reflective strips, or glow sticks so that drivers can see you while trick or treating.

DRESS SAFELY!
Wear layers underneath costumes if the weather is chilly, and make sure there are no tripping hazards on the costume.
