



A new version of CSA Z94.4 Standard entitled Selection, Use, and Care of Respirators is expected to be published in 2011 with some significant changes.

Key changes include:

- New control banding method for selection of respirators for bioaerosols without established occupational exposure limits that are capable of causing infection, adverse or allergic response
- New APFs (Assigned Protection Factors)
- Training has been expanded and includes a new component on fit tester competency
- Change-out procedures no longer allow for the use of warning properties
- Several new appendices to help with the new sections such as selection of respirators for bioaerosols, fit tester competency and illustrations of acceptable facial hair for tight fitting respirators.
