It's that time of year again! Prepare for the back-to-school driving season by following a few simple safety tips.




NEVER pass a school bus while its red lights are flashing and children are entering or exiting the bus.

Exercise caution when approaching a school bus or driving near bus stops. Alternating flashing amber lights mean a bus is slowing down to stop. Do the same.

SLOW DOWN!

The speed limit in school zones is reduced for a reason. Watch for children walking in the street, especially if there are no sidewalks in the neighborhood.





Watch out for bicycles!

Children on bicycles are often inexperienced, unsteady and unpredictable. Slow down and allow at least three feet of passing distance between your vehicle and the bicycle.
